[Maths and English](#) (if you haven't achieved a Grade C or above at GCSE level)

What is expected of me?

To enter this course, you will need a minimum of 5 GCSEs (grade C or above) to include English/Welsh First Language and Maths/Numeracy OR an appropriate Level 2 Diploma qualification at Merit grade with GCSE English/Welsh Language and Maths/Numeracy at grade C or above.

You must have good communication skills and enjoy working as part of a team.

What comes next?

After your two year course, you can progress onto the [HND in Tourism, Hospitality and Event Management](#) at Coleg Gwent (franchised with Cardiff Metropolitan University), gain employment, or progress onto a travel and tourism related university course.

Additional information

You'll be required to purchase a uniform, which will cost between £90 - £140, as well as to pay for trips and visits during the course, which will cost approximately £150.
