

Manual Handling Awareness



In a nutshell

The course covers the general principles of manual handling accident prevention, raising the levels of safety awareness. It will assist in involving employees in health and safety improvement, teach delegates proper lifting techniques (kinetic lifting) and enable them to conduct simple manual handling risk assessments. As such, it can assist in highlighting common hazards likely to be encountered in most workplaces.

This course can be tailored to meet business requirements and working environments.

...all employees, including first line supervisors, with no formal manual handling training.

Identify common hazards likely to be present in the workplace.

Use proper lifting techniques (kinetic lifting).

Conduct simple manual handling risk assessments.

Appreciate relevant legislation - HASWA 1974, Manual Handling Regulations 1992. Appreciate how their actions may endanger themselves, fellow workers or people passing through the workplace.

Identify risks and propose remediation

A health and safety quiz
