

## BPEC Part L (Energy Efficiency)



### In a nutshell

The Energy Efficiency (Part L) training course has been made appropriate to the requirements of plumbers/ heating installers and gas engineers that need to self-certificate their work via one of the Competent Persons Schemes (CPS) and those that carry out work in new and existing dwellings whilst satisfying the requirements for compliance.

This course is available as part of a Personal Learning Account (PLA). PLA is an initiative from the Welsh Government which offers people the chance to access free, part-time courses with flexible and convenient learning that fits around their existing lifestyle (subject to eligibility).

The Energy Efficiency (Part L) is assessed by a short multi-choice theory examination including a heat loss and radiator sizing exercise.

This course is a one day course.

## Entry Requirements

Applicants should be experienced installers of gas, oil, or solid fuel domestic central heating systems.

Evidence/confirmation of experience would be required.

## Additional information

Certificates are normally valid for 5 years.

If completed outside of PLA, this course will cost £225 per candidate.
