COURSE INFORMATION LEAFLET

The course takes place over 1 day and is designed to give you an understanding of:

- the need to prevent accidents
- health and safety law
- how your role fits into the control and management of the site
- risk assessments and method statements
- performing safely and asking for advice
- how to report unsafe acts to prevent an accident

You'll be assessed on your participation throughout the course, including a 25-question multiple choice exam.

Full attendance is mandatory.

On successful completion, you'll receive a certificate valid for 5 years.

There are no formal entry requirements for this course however candidates must be competent in English at operative level.
