Validate your Cloud expertise by taking the Amazon Web Services certification. AWS certifications allow professionals to highlight in-demand skills to current and future employers.

The demand for certified and skilled professionals, who can implement and manage Cloud solutions has grown extensively, with no signs of slowing down, making Cloud Computing the standout career choice. AWS is the leading and most recognised cloud infrastructure in the world, making it an excellent certification to choose when looking to move into a Cloud career.

This course is available as part of a Personal Learning Account (PLA). PLA is an initiative from the Welsh Government which offers people the chance to access free, part-time courses with flexible and convenient learning that fits around their existing lifestyle (subject to eligibility).

Course content

This course is delivered by virtual classroom. Virtual classrooms are equivalent to face-to-face classroom courses, but delivered in an online environment.

Entry Requirements

AWS Cloud Practitioner - This exam is designed for candidates new to Cloud who may not have

an information technology (IT) background. This exam is for line-of-business roles like sales, marketing, product or project management, to get a foundational understanding of AWS Cloud. Candidates for this exam could have up to 6 months of exposure to AWS Cloud, but this is not required.
