What is expected of me?

To qualify for the course, you'll need a minimum of 4 GCSEs, Grade D or above, to include either Maths/Maths Numeracy or English/Welsh First Language, or an appropriate Level 1 Diploma qualification in the relevant vocational area to include either GCSE Maths/Maths Numeracy or English/Welsh First Language.

Full commitment to attendance is required, as well as respect for others, enthusiasm for the subject, self-motivation, creative ability and a desire to succeed. You should have an interest in drama and some basic performance experience.

On successful completion at Merit Level of the Level 2 Diploma, you can apply for the Level 3 Extended Diploma Performing Arts or other Level 3 study.
