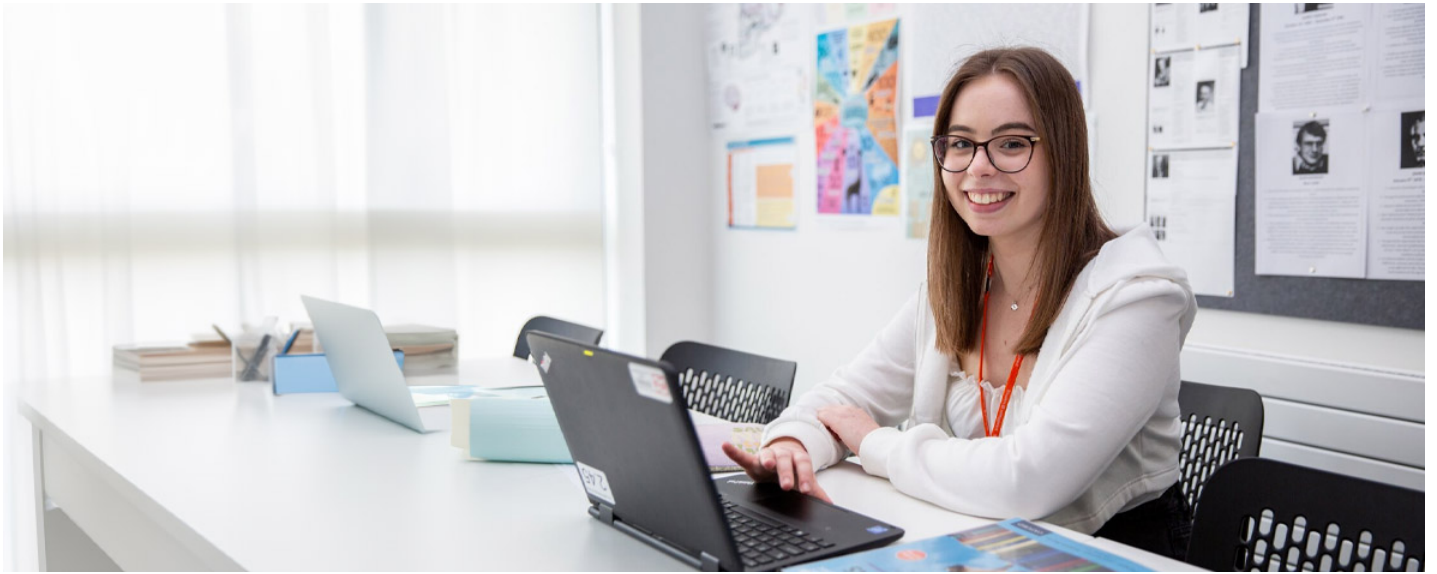


## WJEC AS Level Digital Technology Level 3

A level:

Unit 3 - Connected Systems, Cyber Security and Digital Technology networks (exam)

Unit 4 - Digital Solutions (coursework)

Assessment is based on practical coursework tasks and exams in both the AS and A2 year.

## What is expected of me?

Minimum of 5 GCSEs at grade C or above including Maths at Grade B, English at Grade B.
