### **CAREER TIPS**

- 99% of all medicine and dentistry graduates land a job or further study within 6 months of leaving.
- 98% of all veterinarian graduates find work or future study within 6 months of graduating.
- In 2020 there were 716, 219 nursing jobs in the UK. 89.2% of these roles were filled by females and 10.8 by males. The average wage for a nurse is £37,800 a year.
- 2.48 million people were employed in health or medical roles in 2020. This includes doctors, nurses, dentists and care assistants.
- Private dentists can earn up to £140,000+ annually.
- David Attenborough graduated with a natural sciences degree in 1947.
- Medical and dental technicians can earn up to £30,800. There were 34,198 UK jobs in 2020, 1,946 jobs in Wales. The roles are split evenly between males and females.
- A GP can earn up to £88,700 depending on experience and more if they are a practice partner. A consultant can earn up to £110,683 depending on experience.
- The average Annual Pay for a Medical Practitioner aged 25-34 is £58,682.
- By 2022 the UK will need an estimated 36,205 more Medical Practitioners.
- The UK is a leading Life Sciences Producer and Exporter (Healthcare).
